### **92 Sequum Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley**

**Four Soil Mélange 2003** A Tremendous effort in a bold, opulent style, with layers of rich, extracted blackberry, currant, kirsch and savory, toasty oak flavors that are bold and potent yet in proportion to the wine. Ample tannins for short-term cellaring. Best from 2007 through 2013. 332 cases made. – *J.L.*

### **90 Sequum Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley**

**Four Soil Mélange 2002** A Rich, seductive style, with ripe red currant and black currant flavors, hints of plum and cherry along with a nice dash of cedary lead pencil-laced oak. Gains complexity on the finish, revealing extra depth and concentration. Drink now through 2011. 224 cases made. - *J.L.*
